

Figuring Out Your GPA

- Step 1. Write in the name of your classes.
 Step 2. Write in the grade you received in each class.
 Step 3. Assign a number to your letter grade and write it under “Grade Points.”
- | | |
|-------|---------------|
| A = 4 | D = 1 (Oops!) |
| B = 3 | F = 0 (Ouch!) |
| C = 2 | |
- Step 4. Add up the “Grade Points” column.
 Step 5. Divide “Total Grade Points” by the number of classes you had (7).
 Step 6. Your GPA is the number you get after you divide grade points by number of classes.

Figuring Out Credits Earned

For each class you pass with an A, B, C, D you earn 5 credits per semester. If you earn an F in a class, then unfortunately you earn **0** credits for that class!! In junior high you can earn 35 credits a semester, or 70 credits for the whole year. Just a reminder: a student needs 120 credits to be promoted to high school.
